## ACCOMMODATION

### SELF CATERING LODGES

Each lodge has 4 rooms (3 with a double bed and 1 with a double and a single bed). The cost for the lodge is €580. Lodges can be shared by families at a cost of €145 per room.

### SELF CATERING VILLAS (located on the golf course)

Each villa has 3 rooms with a double and a single bed. The cost for the villa is €480. Villas can be shared by families or by individuals at a cost of €160 per room.

### SELF CATERING COTTAGES

Each cottage has 3 rooms (2 with a double and single bed and 1 with a double bed). The cost for the cottage is €480. Cottages can be shared by families or by individuals at a cost of €160 per room.

### HOTEL (limited number of rooms)

€45 B&B per night per person sharing;  
€55 B&B for single room.

### CAMPSITE

Caravans €26 per day for 2 adults (extra adult or child €6 per day); tents €9 per day per person.
