SELF CATERING LODGES

Each lodge has 4 rooms (3 with a double bed and 1 with a double and a single bed). The cost for the lodge is €600 or £520

Lodges can be shared by families at a cost of €150 or £135 per room.

SELF CATERING VILLAS (located on the golf course)
Each villa has 3 rooms with a double and a single bed.
The cost for the villa is €495 or £435.

Villas can be shared by families or by individuals at a cost of €165 or £145 per room.

SELF CATERING COTTAGES

Each cottage has 3 rooms (2 with a double and single bed and 1 with a double bed). The cost for the cottage is €495 or £435.

Cottages can be shared by families or by individuals at a cost of €165 or £145 per room.
