“One Humanity, One Planet: Synodal Leadership” is an initiative promoted by New Humanity NGO and the Political Movement for Unity, aimed at strengthening the capacities of young political leaders to make an impact in their contexts from a collaborative and global perspective.

The program offers a 6-month virtual learning journey that combines in-depth reflection and dialogue rooted in our different experiences, exchange of projects and practices, development of initiatives with local impact and global outreach.
